Devastating Trishuli Flood has taken Everything

An astonishing news broke out early hours today that most of the National and International media intensively helping us to figuring out what happened exactly in this beautiful hilly country of Nepal! A **rapidly developing disaster causes immensely. Number of casualty and damage figures are still changing.**

The most useful confirmed figures available today include **20 of more deaths reported, hundreds of people unaccounted for, hundreds of residential buildings, unnumbered shops and market areas, 19 bridges and about 40 km of roads damaged, and 14 hydropower projects affected with a combined capacity of about 748 MW.** The flooding has severely affected from Tibet-China to Rasuwa District, and moved downstream through Nuwakot and Dhading along the Bhote Koshi–Trishuli river flowing. The Nepal Government has already allocated **NPR 25 million (Rs. 2.5 crore)** for immediate relief in Rasuwa, Nuwakot and Dhading, while the Nepal Army and private helicopters are involved in rescue operations. Along with the rescue efforts and relief networks are preparing something, the churches and religious communities are also standing in prayerful attempts to help!
